We are very happy to have you as part of our 2010 DreamClinic Italian Spa-Culinary Tour adventure. It's shaping up to be as wonderful as our past trips. We need a \$500.00 per person deposit now and will credit that towards the tour packages of \$3,695.00 with airfare (*fuel surcharges & currency rate fluctuations not included*). If you do our "land-only" package and arrange your own airfare, your tour package cost is \$1,000.00 per person less. Please advise on your enrollment papers.

We have attached several forms. Please look them over and feel free to call me if you have any questions. MAIL ENROLLMENT FORMS TO US as soon as possible. Please sign those forms that request it.

Use **legal names as they appear on your passport**.

- The Culinary Tour Member Information Form: Complete this form with as much current information as possible.
- Traveler Release Form: To be filled out by all travelers, and signed before a notary and notarized.
- Behavior for Culinary Tour Members: Two page listing of our behavior code.
- Agreement of Behavior: One per traveler. Sign this agreement after reading the Behavior Code.
- Credit Card Payment Form: This can be used to prearrange payments using your VISA or MasterCard.

Please complete the above forms, make copies for your self, and **return the originals to us as soon as possible**.

We also STRONGLY encourage you to enroll in some type of trip insurance. You should do this now.

- We also would like 2 legal sized self-addressed & stamped envelopes for mailings.
- We would like **3, clear, black and white copies of your passports**. We cannot use color copies.
- We would like monthly payments in the amount of \$600.00 per person (or propose an alternate plan). The first payment is due by November 15th, 2010. Future payments on or before the 1st of each month (December 1st, January 1st, etc.) and with the last before April 1st, 2010. Late payments cost us penalties. Late payments will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee. For other arrangements or questions, contact Larry.

AGREEMENT OF BEHAVIOR **FOR TOUR MEMBERS**

1. **BASIC RULE:** Tour Group Leaders have the final say on all decisions relating to the tour. Chef instructors have the final say on all decisions when members are in their supervision. Parents/guardians have the final say when “minor-aged” members are under the supervision of those parents/guardians.
2. **General Behavior:** It is expected that general behavior of all tour members will be at the highest level. We believe everyone on this trip has already demonstrated a high level of self-control and maturity, adults and minors alike. However, we recognize that we will be interacting with many other people from many other backgrounds, and we want to encourage everyone in this group to maintain their high level of accepted behavior regardless of what others may suggest or invite them to participate in. Respect of other tour group members is required. Concerns should be brought to the attention of the tour group leader & host as needed.
3. Excessive drinking will not be tolerated and is grounds for expulsion from the tour group.
4. Non-tour group visitors will not be allowed in the hotel rooms. Part of the great opportunity of this trip is to meet new people. Therefore, it is perfectly acceptable for members to connect with new people and make friends. But for safety and security, they may not be invited to our hotel rooms. The public areas are acceptable.
5. Drugs, fireworks, weapons (including pellet guns, knives, swords), pornography, and foul or abusive language (“trash talk”) will not be allowed.
6. At classes, tours and related events, tour members are asked to check in and out with the tour leader or host when leaving the area. At other times, “minor-aged” members will check in and out with their parent/guardian(s) when leaving their company. Guardians must know the whereabouts of their charges at all times.

Agreement of Behavior for TOUR Members

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7. For tour members under 19, a buddy system is required for excursions outside the immediate area of the classes or tour sites. At classes and tours, this means 2 or more. When not at a class, 3 or more are required for side excursions, AND the parent(s)/guardian(s) must have been given approval.
8. We obviously do not expect anyone to get into trouble with the law. However, we do want to make it clear that problems with the law in a foreign country are far more severe than at home. Therefore, we need to be extra careful to abide by the rules of the society that we are visiting. Ask before touching merchandise. Do transactions in view of others. Avoid shady people, places and bargains.
9. Personal safety for yourself and your team members is important on this trip. It is critical to recognize that the traffic rules follow different customs in different countries, and it is important to avoid being run over by a car, bicycle, or train. This may sound humorous, but the pedestrian does not have the clear right-of-way in Europe. If you step out in front of a train, the train will win. If you are standing on a curb and you are pushing or shoving for any reason, and someone gets bumped into the path of a car, the car will win.
10. If a tour member and their charges wish to deviate from a planned meal, tour or event, they are to notify the tour leader on the previous day. That notice must include names, the general destination, and expected return time. Such deviations affect our busses, hotels and tours all of whom require notice.

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Cancellation costs

It is the responsibility of the tour hosts to inform all participants of the cancellation policy. If any individual or the entire group cancels their tour anytime after booking the following cancellation fees will be charged:

1. Between booking and 21 weeks prior to departure: US\$ 200.00 per person.
2. Between 20 weeks and 17 weeks prior to departure: US\$ 350.00 per person.
3. Between 16 weeks and 5 weeks prior to departure: 40% of the participant's price per person plus added cancellation costs for the different suppliers.
4. Between 4 weeks and 1 week prior to departure: 60% of the participant's price per person plus added cancellation costs for the different suppliers.
5. Within one week of departure: 100% of the participant's price per person.

Suppliers present these regulations to L&L/CTI. This policy is in place to protect all members in the group. If your total number of participants changes due to additions/ deletions your participant's price may be adjusted accordingly. In case L&L/CTI uses a supplier with a different cancellation policy we will mention the different conditions on the tour confirmation.

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
